Established in 1905, Neighborhood House is a leading Portland social service agency, assisting thousands of vulnerable children, families and seniors annually in across the metro area. Neighborhood House's programs provide educational support to disadvantaged children, help families facing hunger and homelessness, and assist seniors so that they can continue to live independently.

***Our mission is to bring neighbors together to prevent hunger and homelessness and educate both young and old. We strengthen community by providing resources to support self-reliance, economic independence and dignity in people of all ages and backgrounds.***

We provide a comprehensive array of services for children from the first months of their lives all the way through high school.

Services for children and youth include:

- Head Start Prekindergarten Program and Early Head Start **prepares low-income children for a successful transition to kindergarten;**
- Peninsula Children's Learning Center **supports working families** with sliding scale daycare for 240 children in North and Northeast Portland;
- After-school programming **provides educational support, enrichment and a safe place for children** to be afterschool at 6 Portland schools;
- Our Parenting Program teaches parents, mostly recent immigrants, how to best support their children's healthy development and school readiness.
- The Child Care Improvement Project **provides training to home based child care providers** to improve the quality and educational focus, and to increase the amount of stable and affordable care available to low-income families.

Our Stability and Opportunities Services Program works to prevent hunger and homelessness through our **Emergency Food Box Program**, the largest food pantry on Portland's west side, as well as **providing transitional housing for homeless families**, and resource and referral **support for anyone living in poverty.**

Our Aging Services programming provides case management and transportation assistance to seniors. We also operate two senior centers in downtown and SW Portland to help seniors remain living independently.

The agency's budget for **2016-2017 is \$7.1 million, 20 percent** of which must be raised through private support.
