

## Education:

Early Head Start is a home-based program in which home visitors come to the home weekly and work with the parents using the Parents as Teachers (PAT) curriculum. Monthly group socializations provide children opportunities to practice their social skills with peers.

Head Start uses Creative Curriculum, a play-based curriculum in which children develop the necessary skills in the four developmental domains: cognitive, language and literacy, physical, and social to successfully enter kindergarten. The learning environment in our classrooms is set up in the centers where children learn through interactions with their peers and the teaching staff. The Head Start program uses Teaching Strategies GOLD to observe and assess children's developmental progress throughout the year.
